5th Sunday 30th June at Underbarrow – 5th Sunday planning group will meet today (24th).

St Thomas's is planning a 5th Sunday at the end of September as a CAP service. This will be discussed at the two Valleys 5th Sunday planning meeting as to whether it would be a helpful thing for the Valley churches to join in/participate, or whether to have a joint service with St Thomas's with a speaker at another time.

[Post-meeting – the 5^{th} Sunday planning group decided not to join in with St Thomas's as there had been a speaker from CAP not that long ago at one of our 5^{th} Sunday services. Also, the group wanted to maintain the momentum of the 5^{th} Sunday services, the last two of which have been very well attended.]

Lent Course

This went well, good attendance and positive engagement with open sharing. There are plans for a 'reunion' in September to see how people are progressing with a daily time of prayer/Bible reading.

Various people from the Two Valleys attended David Parson's course on 'Christ through all the Scriptures' during Lent.

Recommended watching

The series 'The Chosen', available on an App, Netflix, Amazon, is being recommended by Michael to his congregations – and to anyone really! It charts the course of all the disciples and other characters around Jesus in an imaginative way, building plausible back-stories and a creative Bible-based narrative, in its cultural context. There will eventually be seven seasons, each of eight sessions.

One of the Two Valleys' House Groups will be watching and discussing it this term. There are study guides and other supporting materials, plus interviews and discussions between those involved in its production, and also critical appraisal.

Mission Community Offer

Healing prayer at Communion was offered at Witherslack and Winster on 21st April. Are there other opportunities to offer healing ministry? Do we offer it on occasions after the end of a service?

Help requested

St Oswald's, Grasmere is in Interregnum; the team was asked if they could cover some Communion and non-Communion services.

Joint PCCs meeting?

A joint meeting of all the PCCs could be a positive way forward to consider our mission, our purpose, and how we go forward in this. It could strengthen our MC bonds, to work towards a common aim. Practically, this would be difficult to arrange, with so many people involved. Instead, possibly ask for three to four from each PCC (volunteers plus invitation) in the first instance for fellowship and discussion.
